Brambles Outdoor Nursery group is a multi-award winning, Ofsted registered nursery group with five settings nestled within the beautiful Wiltshire countryside. We provide a fantastic **OUTDOOR ENVIRONMENT** that allows children to take the lead and gain confidence and independence with encouragement from our caring staff.

We passionately believe that the children learn and thrive surrounded by nature's abundance. We take inspiration from Forest School, Hygge and use a **NATURE BASED APPROACH** to encourage our Bramblers to explore the world using the environment around them to enrich their journey.

We believe wholeheartedly in **WELLNESS**. Our wonderful team of practitioners support children to understand their feelings thought patience, **EMPATHY** and kindness. Our aim is to give children the tools they need to regulate their own emotions, feel safe and work together so that they can become resilient adults who are able to deal with whatever life has to offer.



We are open all year round from 8am to 5pm with 2 sessions.



Our setting is situated within the picturesque market town of Wilton next to fields with a stream with ducks.



We welcome children from 9 months-5 years old. Our Bramblers are split into four Family groups across two gardens.



We have two beautiful gardens with a mature oak tree, a fun mud kitchen and a cosy yurt with a log burner. We also have an indoor space where they enjoy their lunch and the youngest enjoy their sleep.



We are located less than 10 minutes from the villages of Salisbury, Coombe Bissett and Quidhampton.



15 and 30 hours Early Years Government Funding is accepted.



We have an exceptional team of staff and we are dedicated to training and improving ourselves. Our apprentices are supported through a dedicated training programme.



We grow our own herbs and vegetables for the children to look after and we provide a healthy, balanced menu throughout the day and cater to any allergy or dietary requirements.

The Brambles Way

Emotional Wellbeing

At Brambles we believe that helping children understand big emotions is important. We create a safe environment with understanding adults in which they learn strategies that help them become resilient, caring adults. Self regulation happens when the caring adults are able to co-regulate and valuing our teams mental health is part of this process.

The Role of the Environment

The natural environment at Brambles plays an important role by sparking wonder and curiosity. Natural open ended resources promote imagination encouraging children to be creative. Children explore the seasons and we embrace the British weather as a learning opportunity.



The Image of the Child

Children at Brambles are viewed as competent natural researchers. They are investigators and curious problem solvers who are full of knowledge, potential and interest in the world around them.

The Languages of the Child

Children have many ways to discover, think, communicate and learn. At Brambles we believe it is important to give children endless ways to express their thoughts and theories and support them whilst they investigate new ideas.

Role of the Family

At Brambles, we value our partnership with families. Parents are encouraged to share children's interests, milestones, and photos from home, while our daily updates keep families connected and involved in their child's learning journey.

The Role of the Practitioners

At Brambles, practitioners work alongside children, valuing their ideas and interests. They inspire learning through play, modelling, encouraging, and extending each child's curiosity.



An Emergent Learning Process

At Brambles, we believe that a play- and enquiry-based environment challenges children and helps them make sense of the world, centering on their interests, explorations, curiosity, and the world around them. Through exploration, children learn at their own pace, valuing each child's experiences and choices. Play and learning focus on the process, not the product, fostering creativity, confidence, and a lifelong love of learning.

Robins & Squirrels

9 months -2 years old

In Robins and Squirrels we have some wonderful opportunities for our youngest children. We love exploring messy play. We use paint, chalk and mud to investigate. Squirrels love our mud kitchen and add herbs, flowers and spices for them to explore. We also have a mud pit that we love to squelch and stomp in. We encourage children to enjoy art in our creative art station.

We love to read stories and singing songs in our cosy corner with blankets and fairy lights. We have a bespoke sleeping area with handmade beds for children to nap.



Owls

2-3 years old

Our Owls garden is large and full of exciting, adventurous and creative areas that allow young children to express themselves through open-ended play.

Owls are able to thrive from both the supportive adults and the older Fox children who are also in the garden.

We provide the Owls with plenty of learning opportunities from preparing their own snack to understanding their own feelings and emotions as well as beginning to understand how to control them and build on them.

We start to learn the fire circle rules, spending time together around our fire cooking and being social with each other. We keep warm and make breakfast, snack and tea together.



Foxes

3-5 years old

Foxes enjoy a large garden which presents a range of open-ended play opportunities in which they can share their own experiences and imaginations using loose parts alongside their peers.

Foxes are continuously supported by the adults when it comes to self-regulation and taking control of their feelings where possible.

Foxes are exceptional knowledge seekers who are able to understand the safety of the fire circle as well as guide the younger Owls by being their role models.

We involve the children in everything throughout the day and they often take the lead, cooking on the fire, washing up, building structures and resources to play with.



Meals at Brambles

At Brambles we understand the importance of offering children a varied, healthy and nutritionally balanced meals. We provide a nutritious breakfast to start the day. Our morning snack is cooked on an open fire. We also enjoy a freshly cooked hot meal for our lunch each day.

We are able to cater to any allergies and have a full list of ingredients and allergens list on request.

Children have independence to choose food options for themselves from our fruit and vegetable bowls.

Children booked onto our Working Day receive breakfast, lunch, a morning and afternoon snack and afternoon tea.

Children booked onto our School Day receive lunch and a morning and afternoon snack.



Funding & Fees

Government funding is designed to cover the basic EYFS provision, but it doesn't extend to meals, snacks, daily essentials, or the exciting extra experiences that make early learning truly special.

At Brambles Wilton, our Enhanced Provision offers your child so much more than the standard EYFS offering. From enriching outdoor adventures and creative learning activities to all daily essentials—nappies, wipes, sun cream—and healthy, delicious meals and snacks, every day is filled with opportunities for exploration, growth, and joy.

At Brambles, we continually invest in our outdoor spaces and resources to provide safe, inspiring experiences every day. Choosing our Enhanced Provision is more than a nursery place—it's a premium early years experience that nurtures growth, exploration, and a lifelong love of learning.

The Government funding is for 38 weeks of the year or Term Time only. Brambles Wilton is open for 50 weeks a year. We are able to stretch the Government funding to cover our longer opening period.
