Emotional Wellbeing

At Brambles we believe that helping children understand big emotions is important. We create a safe environment with understanding adults in which they learn strategies that help them become resilient, caring adults. Self regulation happens when the caring adults are able to co-regulate and valuing our teams mental health is part of this process.

The Role of the Environment

The natural environment at Brambles plays an important role by sparking wonder and curiosity. Natural open ended resources promote imagination encouraging children to be creative. Children explore the seasons and we embrace the British weather as a learning opportunity.



The Image of the Child

Children at Brambles are viewed as competent natural researchers. They are investigators and curious problem solvers who are full of knowledge, potential and interest in the world around them.

The Languages of the Child

Children have many ways to discover, think, communicate and learn. At Brambles we believe it is important to give children endless ways to express their thoughts and theories and support them whilst they investigate new ideas.

9 months - 2 years

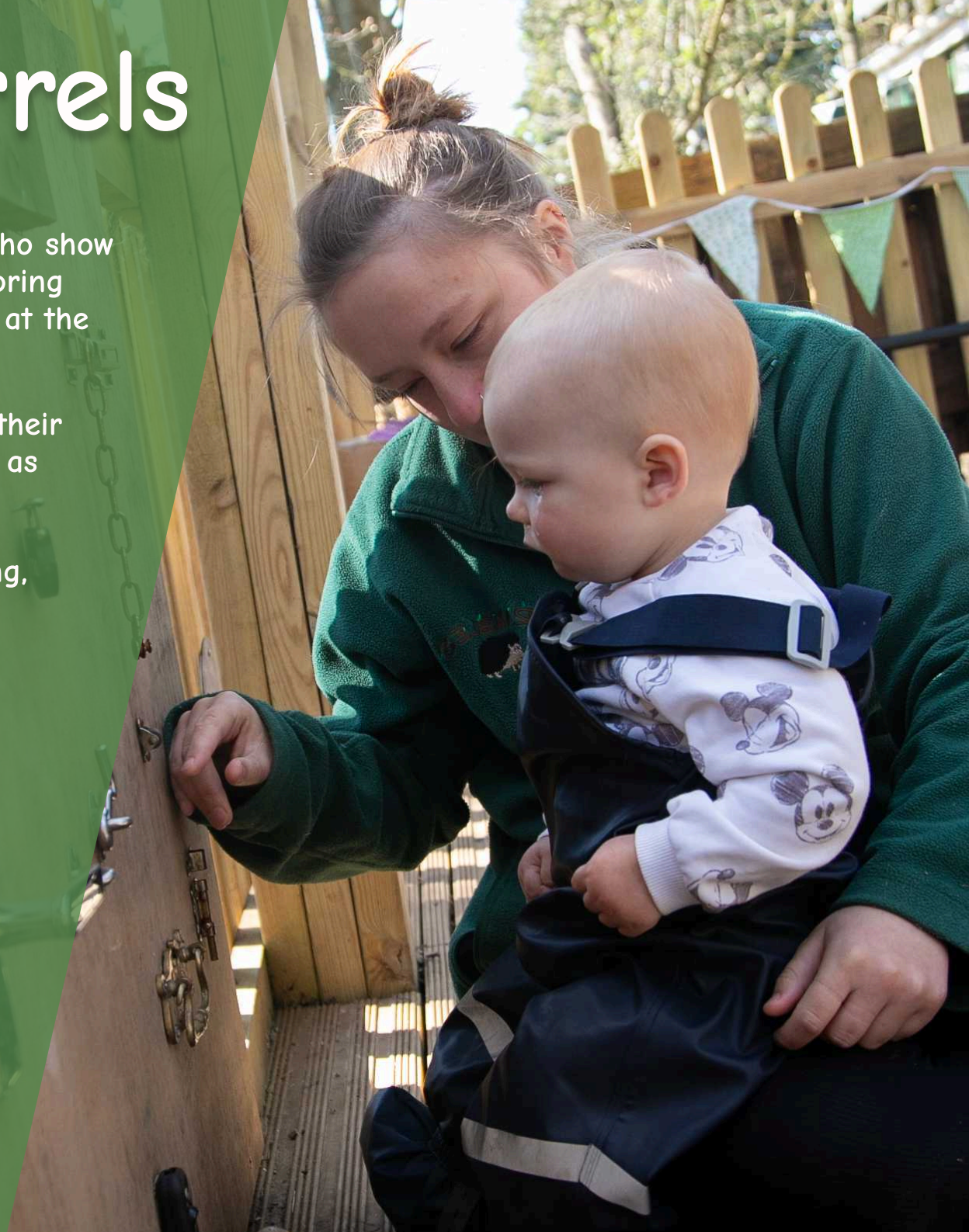

They start to learn lots of new skills such as standing, walking and feeding themselves with the caring and nurturing support of key people.

At Brambles, we fully understand the importance of children being able to recharge and sleep whether that be snuggled in a carrier or in our dedicated sleep area in one of our wonderfully comfortable floor beds.

Our garden space is designed to help our youngest of children enjoy the best of the natural world, whilst having the comforts of home in a true home from home environment.



Owls

2-3 years old

In Owls we have a large colourful garden with a variety of wildlife that we can watch and learn from, including mini beasts and birds that visit us daily. We enjoy taking our first steps to independence learning how to use the toilet in our dedicated cabin bathroom.

We start to learn the fire circle rules, spending time together around our fire cooking and being social with each other. We keep warm and make breakfast, snack and tea together.

We promote creative thinking by using natural resources alongside recycled ones and encouraging the children to use these in imaginative ways.

We love being outside with nature all year round as it provides us with lots of learning opportunities as we watch the seasons change.

We have a wonderful team who all support each other and develop our knowledge and skills, which in turn helps the children.



Foxes

3-5 years old

Our Foxes is unique and ever changing as we create the environment with the children daily.

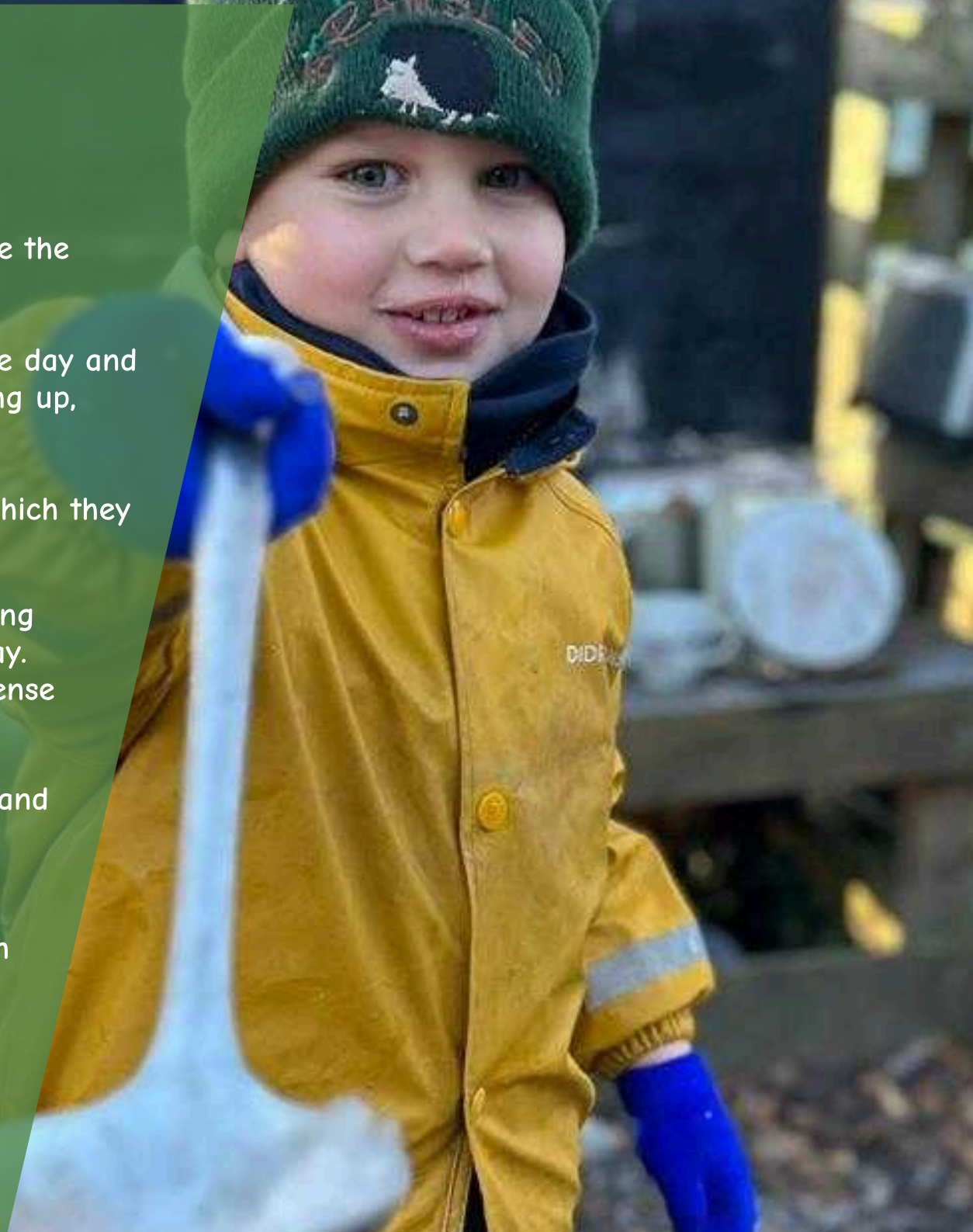
We involve the children in everything throughout the day and they often take the lead, cooking on the fire, washing up, building structures and resources to play with.

Foxes team have a wealth of practical experience which they share with the children.

We invest in STEM - Science, Technology, engineering and Mathematics - and we embed it in everyday play. This encourages our Foxes to question and make sense of the world around them.

The children continue their independence in Foxes and use their own dedicated cabin bathroom.

We really value our families and parents and love creating positive relationships, where you can join in with events such as our Parent Breakfasts and big Summer Festival, Bramblebury.



Meals at Brambles

At Brambles we understand the importance of offering children a varied, healthy and nutritionally balanced meals. We provide a nutritious breakfast to start the day. Our morning snack is cooked on an open fire. We also enjoy a freshly cooked hot meal for our lunch each day.

We are able to cater to any allergies and have a full list of ingredients and allergens list on request.

Children have independence to choose food options for themselves from our fruit and vegetable bowls.

Children booked onto our Working Day receive breakfast, lunch, a morning and afternoon snack and afternoon tea.

Children booked onto our School Day receive lunch and a morning and afternoon snack.



Funding & Fees

Government funding is designed to cover the basic EYFS provision, but it doesn't extend to meals, snacks, daily essentials, or the exciting extra experiences that make early learning truly special.

At Brambles Warminster, our Enhanced Provision offers your child so much more than the standard EYFS offering. From enriching outdoor adventures and creative learning activities to all daily essentials—nappies, wipes, sun cream—and healthy, delicious meals and snacks, every day is filled with opportunities for exploration, growth, and joy.

At Brambles, we continually invest in our outdoor spaces and resources to provide safe, inspiring experiences every day. Choosing our Enhanced Provision is more than a nursery place—it's a premium early years experience that nurtures growth, exploration, and a lifelong love of learning.

The Government funding is for 38 weeks of the year or Term Time only. Brambles Warminster is open for 50 weeks a year. We are able to stretch the Government funding to cover our longer opening period.
